

**NASA Mid-Atlantic welcomes YOU as an HPDE student at Summit Point Raceway on June 21, 22 2008!**

This HPDE will be occurring in conjunction with the 7th annual Hyperfest Event at Summit Point.

**Because this will be a spectator event, some procedures will differ from our typical NASA Mid-Atlantic events. Please read the following information closely.**

**GATE HOURS:** Gates open at 5:30PM Friday June 20th and will remain open all night. It is highly suggested that you arrive by 6:45AM Saturday morning due to the mandatory 7:15AM meeting. There may be congestion at the gate, so please arrive early. **Do not arrive earlier than 5:30 PM on Friday because there is another NON NASA event on track that day and you will NOT be allowed in.**

**GETTING THROUGH THE GATE:** **Since this is a spectator event, the track staff will be collecting a gate fee of \$20 per person for EVERYONE. Please be prepared with cash.**

**These fees will be refunded for all drivers at the tech shed between 10AM and 2PM on Saturday (no exceptions).** Once you get your participant wristband (that indicates you are a driver), you can claim your refund. HPDE participants are allowed **ONE** free crew member. That crew member can accompany you to the refund station, or you can write the person's name down at the refund station. When the free crew person arrives, he must go to the refund station between 10AM and 2PM on Saturday (no exceptions) to obtain a refund. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER 2PM ON SATURDAY.**

**PROCEDURES:** Normal NASA Mid-Atlantic procedures will be followed for obtaining both your on-track wristband and tech sticker. **YOU MUST WEAR BOTH WRISTBANDS** (gate and participant wristbands) **ALL WEEKEND.** HPDE participants will only be allowed one car in the paddock area, and you will be given a paddock pass. Any open trailers should be parked in Turn 10 or in the camping area toward Turn 1. Friends, crew and family must park in general parking or in the woods near the paddock. **NO EXCEPTIONS. PLEASE CONSERVE SPACE AS THIS WILL BE A VERY WELL ATTENDED EVENT.**

**HPDE 1 and HPDE 2:** You will receive your participant wristband at your first classroom session. Your car will be inspected by your instructor on grid prior to your first on-track session, and you will receive your tech sticker at that time. **You DO NOT need to check in at the techistration area. Make sure you attend the ALL HANDS meeting at 7:15 AM AT THE TECH SHED AREA.** To get your tech sticker, you must have the pre-tech form completed and signed, so do this prior to going to grid. Your instructor will go over your pre-tech form and do a tech inspection of your car. If you are knowledgeable about your car and are competent to check all items on the form, you may complete the form yourself. **HPDE 3:**

In HPDE 3 (advanced group), you are not assigned an instructor. HPDE 3 Level indicates that you have significant experience on a variety of tracks, and your experience will be verified.

**You must report to techistration to retrieve your on-track wristband, and you need to bring your car through the tech shed to receive your tech sticker.** Please give your completed pre-tech sheet to a tech official and check in at the registration table to retrieve your wristband. **EVERYONE MUST ATTEND THE 7:15 AM SATURDAY ALL HANDS MEETING NEAR TECH SHED! THERE IS ALSO A MANDATORY ALL HANDS MEETING ON SUNDAY MORNING AT THE TECH SHED.**

Please see schedule for your first classroom time and first on-track session. Although we try our best to make announcements for your track time, you should pay careful attention to the time and what group is on track so you will know when to report to grid. Always be aware of what group is prior to yours so you will know when to report to grid.

**CAR NUMBER:** Your car number is your 1st preference unless you have been or are notified of the need for a change. **You are responsible to have your car numbered before it will be allowed on the track.**
