



We look forward to seeing you at the 2023 Haltech HyperFest!

Please read all of the information below regarding ticketing and camping. The schedule will be posted early next week and the live driver list is here: https://members.drivenasa.com/events/4189/entry_list

1. Each registered driver gets one free ticket for themselves and one free ticket for one (guest).
2. Each registered driver may purchase up to 4 tickets at a discounted price of \$45 per ticket.
3. Ages 12 and under are free admission.
4. Purchase a camping ticket at the link if camping is needed. Camping credentials will be monitored by a paddock marshall. If you are staying on site all weekend in your RV, trailer or tent you must have a camping pass. **NOTE: Electricity is sold by VIR and is first come first served.**
 - RV Camping \$140 – Choose if you have a Motorhome/RV
 - Trailer/Tent camping \$80 – Choose if you are sleeping in a car trailer, tent or popup camper of 20 feet or less.

The ticketing platform is **Torkhub** and all registered drivers must complete the approval form using [this link](#). Please allow our team 48 hours to approve the entries. Once approved, you will get an email from Torkhub confirming your acceptance. Click on the link in the email and you will be able to get your free ticket and allocate one free ticket to a guest. You will also see a purchase tickets button that will allow you to purchase camping and up to 4 discounted tickets for other guests. It is the driver's responsibility to allocate the tickets to guests. The driver and guests must come to NASA Driver Check-In on site at VIR.

GATE HOURS FOR HYPERFEST: NASA Driver Check-in will close at 11PM each night and reopen at 6AM. When you are arriving for the first time at the event, you must arrive at NASA Driver Check-in during open hours noted below to get your credentials. The gate will only be open between 11PM-6AM each night to people that have already entered the facility and have a gate wristband. If you do not have a gate wristband, you cannot enter the facility. Once you have received your credentials from the box office, you will be able to enter/exit the venue 24 hours a day provided you keep your credentials. Please adjust your travel plans accordingly.

This event will have some Friday only drivers, some Fri/Sat/Sun drivers and most drivers will be Sat/Sun drivers.

The driver (and your one free crew) will present the ticket, sign the waiver, and get the gate wristband. The one free crew person and up to 4 guests with discounted tickets may arrive separately from the driver and will check-in at NASA Check-In.

Paddock Passes and Paddock Rules

The Driver Paddock will open at 6PM Thursday. If you arrive prior to 6PM Thursday, you will be in a holding area. Each driver will receive a paddock pass allowing ONE support vehicle into the Main NASA (North) Paddock. Due to the number of drivers at this event, crew and guests must park in general parking. There will be a person stationed at the entrance of North Paddock to monitor paddock stickers 24 hours a day. You may save one space in North Paddock for one NASA Driver until 8AM Friday. Paddock officials will be removing cones, caution tape on Friday morning at 8AM. Towing will be used if vehicles are left to reserve a space. Please conserve space and only use what you need. All drivers must be located in North Paddock, and there is sufficient room if people conserve space and be neighborly. Again, crew and guests must park in general parking and will not be allowed to drive into North Paddock.
